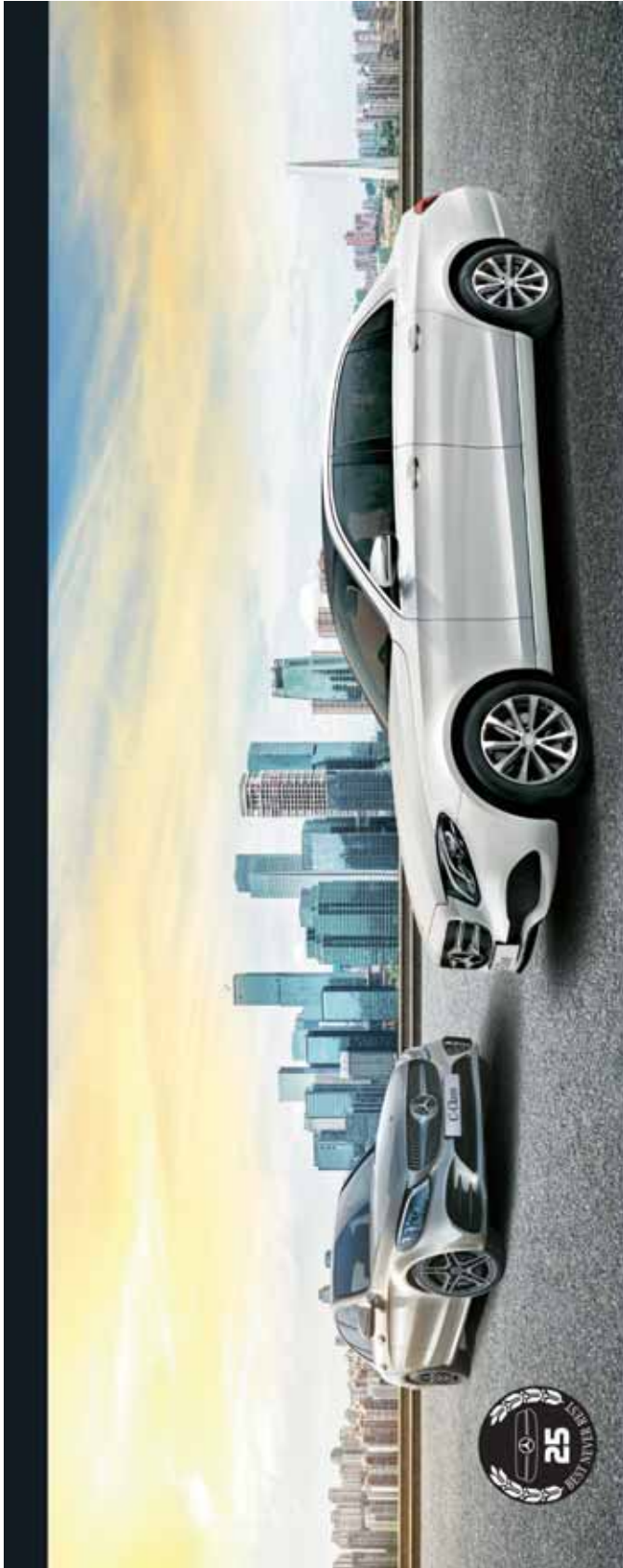

MPCB convened Meeting of Industries

Maharashtra Pollution Control Board Navi Mumbai Regional Officer Dr. Anant Harshwardhan had convened meeting of Industries of Thane Belapur Industrial Belt on 5th February, 2019 at 4 pm at TBIA office to brief them on the NGT orders passed recently regarding air pollution issues in 120 cities of India, Navi Mumbai was one of them, Further to discuss on the same and prepare time bound action.

More than **37 participants** attended the above said meeting.

Dr. Harshwardhan focused on:

- Implementation of multi stage scrubber as abatement of Air Pollution.
- Drainage lines if worn out, to inform MIDC & raise concern with MPCB.
- Solvent based distillation unit – Sampling done by MPCB. Up gradation of air pollution control systems.
- Textile to switch over to Briquette/PNG.

Dr. Harshwardhan appealed to Industries to raise their concern / suggestions for improvement in Air Pollution / Water Pollution levels, also if any Industries does malpractices, to inform MPCB. He assured that complainant identity will be kept secret.

**Mock Drill & Simulation Exercise,
30th & 31st January 2019.**

& 31st January 2019. The main objective of this activity was to train & check the efficacy of Emergency Support Functionaries in dealing with an unprecedented emergency.

Back Ground

The MHA (Ministry of Home Affairs)-USAID (United States agency for International Development) -UNDP (United Nations Development Programme) Partnership Project on Developing Resilient Cities through Risk Reduction in the context of Disaster and Climate Change is implementing at Navi Mumbai Municipal Corporation for the period 2016-2020. The current Project is being implemented at 5 city Corporations other than Navi Mumbai, ie, Shimla, Shillong, Cuttack, Vijayawada, Vishakhapatnam. This project aims at enhancing the institutional Capacity & Preparedness of various stakeholders including Government organization, Private Sector entities, & Communities towards reducing disaster risks (both natural & manmade).

With reference to this project, a simulation exercise & mock drill for Offsite Emergency was organised for stakeholders responding to Industrial Disasters at Uran Phata Road on 30th

Goals and Objectives

The goals and objectives of the exercise were as follows:

- To harness the strengths and capabilities of emergency responders, mutual aid response groups, industrial associations, hospitals, humanitarian agencies and city stakeholders as they prepare to confront urban catastrophes.





- To increase local capacities for disaster preparedness and response by promoting awareness among communities, administrators, and other stakeholders.

Scenario

- Incident: - Ammonia Gas Tanker meets with an accident rupturing the valve and there is heavy leakage of gas. Driver is safe.
- Local Response- by driver of the vehicle and community in area to the Incident
- Action by local administrative machinery, including traffic constable
- Action at NMMC, Emergency Operation Centre
- First responders responding to the incident- Ascertain damage, requisitioning need based resources, planned evacuation and cordoning area.
- Involvement of MARG- Technical specialist, identifying Red/Orange and Green zones
- Incident affected area- 500 mtr radius area. Deliberate Response planned by Incident Commander
- Role of Media
- Preparedness check of Medical Agencies, Fire and Industry department
- Preparation of after action report

Key Deliverables

The outcomes of the exercise is summarised below.

- **Orientation:** An Orientation on offsite emergency management response, pre- hospital emergency management including mass casualty emergency events and Emergency Trauma Care was given to respective stakeholders in the city.
- **Table Top:** It has provided an opportunity for all the stakeholders to work together in coordinated response to a city disaster.
- **Field Drill:** Real time simulation of a mass casualty event involving multi-agency coordination, communication and response, testing the efficacy of

individual stakeholders.

- **Debriefing:** Post drill hot wash identifying the strengths and weaknesses in current plans. This has helped to identify areas needing further training and capacity building.
- **Evaluation:** Experts in disaster management were invited to observe and evaluate the entire exercise and to make recommendations for future improvement.
- **Potential Impact:** This exercise has prompted the subsequent translation of policy into practice & action along with a concrete understanding on gaps & strengths of the stakeholders. This collaborative exercise and its evaluation component had tremendous value to the city corporation as it had brought all the relevant stakeholders on a single platform.

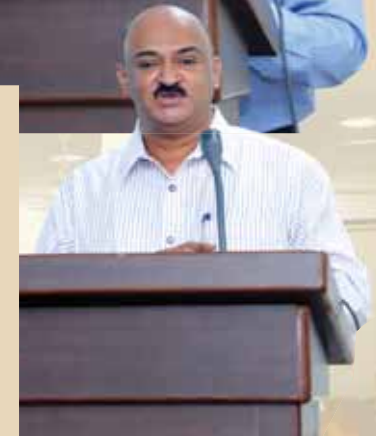

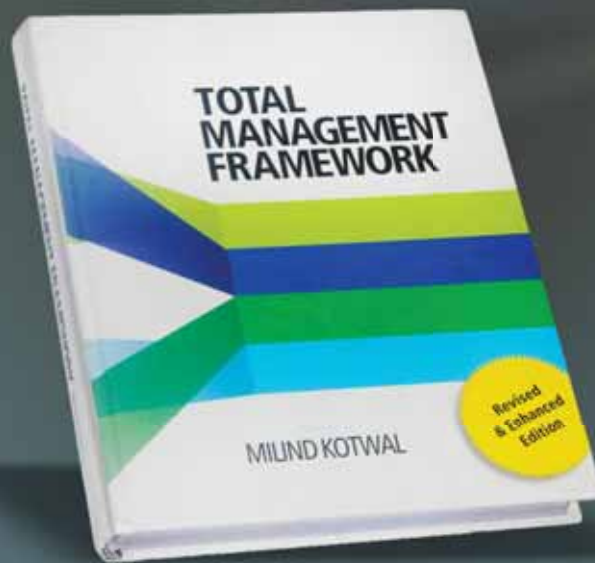

We are in manufacturing sector for us electricity is production input For maximization of our profit we take various measures such as improving productivity, reducing finance cost etc. One of the measures has been reducing electricity cost .Roof top solar meaning "NET METERING" is one of the measures. Solar panels are installed on our premises A import /export meter is installed. Here we use electricity supplied by MSEDCL. Simultaneously panels generate electricity during the day from solar so say 100 units consumed and say 30 solar generations. So now Rs. 100- Rs. 30 =Rs. 70 is billed to us As such industries tariff being Rs9 approximately our saving was $Rs\ 9 \times 30 = Rs. 270$ This was a great saving This net metering was a boon to industry One of the main reason of this concept was at that time solar prices were as high as Rs 17. Now they have come down to Rs 3.

Now Net metering concept is going to undergo major change. There will be two meters One meter will measure consumption and other one will measure solar generation There is no subtraction method will be available. You pay Rs. 9 for consumption and you will get roughly only Rs. 3 for solar generation Will industry go in solar for Rs. 3? Answer will be NO Who wants all this botheration? Because it is not our core business to generate electricity so what can be done? We still generate solar but whenever it is available then some area by a selector switch use solar and not use of MSEDCL Thus we reduce on our own MSEDCL consumption and earn our Rs 9 Still this is possible. In the long run solar is a game changer which will take industry away from all discount. It is high time they accept and learn to respect industry.
