From the President's Desk

Dear Members,

The last quarter from April to June 2019 was full of political activities in the Country with many predictions and assumptions which all came to rest on 23rd May, 2019 with thumping majority for Mr. Narendra Modi and the BJP.

Another key point of discussion is the budget presented by the government. I am a little disappointed that there is no mention of pharma or chemical industry in the budget. The Prime Minister has launched ambitious schemes like Ayushman Bharat, which can't succeed without participation of pharma industry. There should have been greater focus on MSME's. Earlier, it used to take around 3 years for this sector to break even. Now this period has increased to almost 6 years. In such a scenario the FM should have concentrated on creating an environment more conducive to attract private investment in this sector. The simplification of tax procedure though is a welcome step and it will create confidence among investors. The move to bring companies with Rs. 400 crore turnover in the 25% bracket is also welcome as it will lead to greater investment. However, it's disappointing that the FM has lost an opportunity to rationalise the dividend distribution tax which in fact amounts to double taxation.

At TBIA, as usual we had a very interesting quarter where a number of important events were organised. At TBIA we have always been instrumental in hosting different seminars and workshops. After all, the key to growth and success is constant upgradation of knowledge. In today's fast changing world and work environment this becomes really important. We try our best to cover a diverse range of topics that will appeal to members.
