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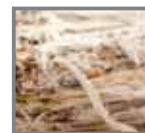
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TBIA F&ERS Get Together

TBIA & GST SEVA KENDRA, CGST Belapur organised STAKEHOLDER FEEDBACK DIVAS ON "NEW GST RETURNS" as a facilitation and hand-holding measure the CBIC held on Saturday the 07Septembr, 2019 at TBIA Conference Hall, Navi Mumbai.

Objective behind the Session :

As you all must be aware that CBIC has decided to introduce new returns in Form ANX-1, ANX-2 (auto-generated), RET-1/RET-2/RET-3 (one of the three is required to be filed as per the requirement of the taxpayer) which would replace the existing returns GSTR-1 and GSTR-3B with effect from 1st April, 2020. The Forms ANX-1 and ANX-2 are available on GSTN in the taxpayer's login for trial. These trial returns will not have any implication on the present day returns to be filed by a taxpayer.

TEAM LEASE WAGE CODE BILL, 2019

on 5th December, 2019 at TBIA Office, Rabale, Navi Mumbai

Objective behind the session

Pursuant to the recommendations of Second National Commission on Labour and with a view to rationalize the Central labour enactment relating to wages, the Ministry of Labour and Employment introduced the Code on Wages, 2017 in the Lok Sabha on August 10, 2017. However, the said Code lapsed upon dissolution of the Sixteenth Lok Sabha. On July 23, 2019, the Ministry re-introduced the Code on Wages, 2019 ("Code") in the Lok Sabha. Both Houses of the Parliament have now passed the Code. The Code on wages, 2019 Bill has now become an Act since it has received the assent of the President of India on 8.08.2019. The Act has not been enforced so far because Govt. has yet to notify the date of applicability of the complete Act or different dates for different provisions for commencement of the Code.

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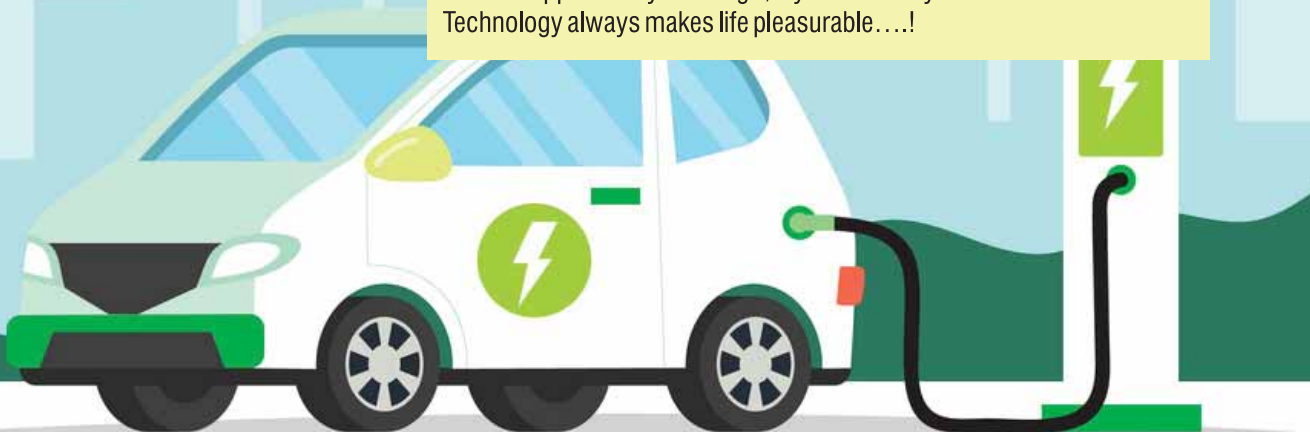
Presently electric car is being pushed as world saver. Some of the advantages are less pollution. Noise less. Low running cost. Easy to maintain because no of parts are very few with respect to Internal combustion [ICE] cars meaning petrol and diesel cars. If we use electricity to charge these cars generated by coal then they we have added pollution. Though say 20/25 % compared to ICE cars. Better method would be if electricity generated is by solar or wind or hydro meaning renewable energy method then we have achieved a lot.

Having said then why electric cars sales are not picking up? Many reasons, First is cost Mahindra and Tata cars are Rs10/12 lakhs.

Also with one charge they cannot go beyond 100/120 KM as against this Hyundai and MG cars go upto 400 /425 KM but cost around Rs 24/25 lakhs. Also these are small size cars so price and distance travelled between two charges is a big deterrent. Small car from Maruti stable say Alto costs only Rs 3 lakhs. So cost has to come down.

These cars run on batteries, So they need charging, Full charge take around 7/8 hours. Say you need in top models to travel only say 100 KM then you have dynamic charging. This will be in around 30 minutes so there is a hassle in charging, As against in five minutes you do full tank and go. We have petrol pumps along say Mumbai Pune highway; we have no electric charging station along the way. In big cities most of the cars are parked on roads in some cases society parking lots not in your garages so at night if you want to charge how individuals will do is big question.

These cars run on Lithium Oxide batteries as the years pass price of these cars is coming down at enormous rate. Almost 50/55% cost the electric cars are of batteries. In the future we are sure car prices will come down and it will compete with ICE cars, Also technology is developing and charging will be faster and also distance travelled i will be more. Needless to less pollution and hence more liveable earth. My gut feeling is this should happen in say coming 5/7 years where you will see the difference. Technology always makes life pleasurable....!

SCHEME, 2019

Directorate General of Taxpayer Services

CENTRAL BOARD OF INDIRECT TAXES & CUSTOMS

TBIA organised meeting with Directorate General of Taxpayer Services of CENTRAL BOARD OF INDIRECT TAXES & CUSTOMS to aware the industries about the Scheme launched by GST Seva Kendra, CGST & CEX Belapur Commissionerate. Mr. Shirish Gogate Superintendent, GST Seva Kendra along with his team made presentation to the members and gave a brief about the Scheme.

The brief about the Scheme:

The Scheme basically aims at reducing litigation under Central Excise and Service Tax. The Scheme offers total waiver of penalty and interest liable to be paid by an assesses. Even huge relief has been offered [from 40% to 70%] on the tax dues payable. The Scheme has been operational from 01.09.2019 to 31.12.2019. All the operations like filing the declaration, issue of discharge certificates, payments, etc. are fully automated and online.

Objectives

- One time measure for liquidation of past disputes of Central Excise and Service Tax
- To provide an opportunity of voluntary disclosure to non-compliant taxpayers.

Cases covered under the Scheme

- A show cause notice or appeals arising out of a show cause notice pending as on the 30th day of June, 2019
- An amount in arrears



- An enquiry, investigation or audit where the amount is quantified on or before the 30th day of June, 2019
- A voluntary disclosure.

Exclusions from the Scheme

- Cases in respect of excisable goods set forth in the Fourth Schedule to the Central Excise Act, 1944 (this includes tobacco and specified petroleum products)
- Cases for which the taxpayer has been convicted
- under the Central Excise Act, 1944 or the Finance Act, 1944
- Cases involving erroneous refunds
- Cases pending before the Settlement Commission.

Benefits under the Scheme

- Total waiver of interest, penalty and fine
- Immunity from prosecution
- Cases pending in adjudication or appeal, a relief of 70% from the duty demand if it is Rs. 50 Lakh or less and 50% if it is more than Rs. 50 Lakh
- The same relief for cases under investigation and audit where the duty involved is quantified on or before 30th June, 2019
- In case of an amount in arrears, the relief offered is 60% of the confirmed duty amount if the same is Rs. 50 Lakh or less and it is 40% in other cases
- In cases of voluntary disclosure, the declarant will have to pay full amount of disclosed duty.

Other features of the Scheme

- Facility for adjustment of any deposits of duty already made
- Settlement dues to be paid in cash electronically only and cannot be availed as input tax credit later
- A full and final closure of the proceedings in question. The only exception is that in case of voluntary disclosure of liability, there is provision
- to reopen a false declaration within a period of one year
- Proceedings under the Scheme shall not be treated as a precedent for past and future liabilities
- Final decision to be communicated within 60 days of application
- No final decision without an opportunity for personal hearing in case of any disagreement
- Proceedings under the Scheme will be fully automated.

- **Environment Protection**

Nature teaches man, enables him, and fills him with sense of beauty. People can live only in balance with the nature. Protection of the environment has thus acquired great political significance and is one of the most important problem facing the mankind.

- **Development activities**

At the same time development activities such as growth of industries and agriculture are must for wealth creation and employment generation for the nation. Infrastructure development such as roads, bridges etc also has to keep pace with growth of developmental activities.

- **Sustainable development**

It is therefore clear from above that development activities cannot be abandoned because of fear of



pollution or environment degradation. Scientists and others have to devote their attention on how to effectively contain pollution and threat to environment arising from such development. The development effort should yield maximum social benefit at minimal environment cost. Development and environment conservation should co exist. This can be broadly called "sustainable development".

- **Development of industries in TTC Ind. Area**

Trans Thane Creek indl. Area is situated 50 kms away from Bombay across the Creek on the Thane Belapur Road. The TTC Industrial area is 18 Km long and 5 Km wide. Giants of the chemical Industry both foreign and Indian have set up a full range of chemical plants producing a vast spectrum of chemicals essential for India's growing economy. Some of these companies are Nocil, BASF, SI Group, Apar Industries Ltd, Mukund Iron, and Siemens India. Lubrizol (I) Amines and Plasticizer etc.

In addition to the Industries mentioned above, a large number of small scale chemical industries have been setup here to produce a variety of fine chemicals, perfumery chemicals, drugs and their intermediates etc. Allied Engineering Industries like mechanical and electrical have also been developed in the area.

The industries manufacture products to high standards of quality using high technology with very high safety standards.

- **Chemical Industry and environment in TTC Industrial Area Liquid effluent**

The chemical industry uses large qty of water. Most of this water is recirculated and reused but some of it has to be discharged as effluent. The effluent discharged from these industries is transported through underground effluent collection lines to "common Effluent Treatment plant" CETP set up by TBIA. In CETP collected effluent is treated by the process of Biodegradation. The treated liquid effluent from CETP is discharged into TTC creek. The quality of this liquid effluent is monitored round the clock and data fed to MPCB HQ by SCADA installed by CETP. The quality parameters of liquid effluent discharged to TTC creek are much lower than the standards laid down by MPCB, as exhibited in chart below:

- **MPCB Standard**

CETP Installed by TBIA has received two Vasundhra Green awards in the years 2015 and 2018. The effluent handling capacity of CEPT is 27 millions Liters/day. The total membership of CETP is more than 3500.

- **Ambient Air Quality**

Industries in this area have undertaken major engineering and technological modification to reduce air pollution. In order to minimize emission of So₂, Colco₂ gas industries have discontinued use of furnace oil as fuel. Instead industries are using piped natural gas (PNG). PNG is clean and green fuel. Ambient air quality is measured at following air quality monitoring stations (AAQM).

It can be seen from the above that pollutants in ambient air are well below the limits specified.

Disposal of Hazardous waste

TBIA was first to set up secured land fill site for disposal of Hazardous waste as per Hazardous waste management rules. This facility is known as TTC Waste Management Association (TTCWMA). MIDC allotted a plot measuring 70,000m² at mahape MIDC area. Since inception till date 5.5 lakhs M tons of Hazardous waste has been disposed off at this site. This site has 3 secured land fill cells.

Tree plantation and afforestation

Air pollution effects can be reduced by growing trees which absorb the pollutions and improve the air quality. Trees are nature's great gift to man to maintain ecological balance. It is a great purifier of polluted air. Only trees can assimilate CO₂. Even the suspended particulate matter (SPM) get deposited on leaves of the trees thus reducing the concentration of SPM the in Air. Trees absorb a lot of heat energy from the atmosphere resulting in a substantial reduction in ambient temperature. TBIA has undertaken massive afforestation programme in this area. So far lakhs of trees have been planted inside / outside the factory premises. Every year on the occasion of World Environment Day, TBIA members with active support of MIDC are planting hundreds of trees in this area.

Sustainable development

The details provided above illustrate that development and environment protection can co-exist and is a clear example of sustainable development.

Great Dandi March
