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# COVID 19

## Impact Assessment & Business Continuity Planning

Thane Belapur Industries Association in association with SUHRUD Consultants organised Session on "Assessing Impact of COVID -19 and Business Continuity Planning" on 3rd May, 2020  
Charudatta Pande, Managing Partner of Suhrud Consultants, conducted a session of Assessing the Impact of COVID 19 on the Indian Industry and Business Continuity Planning

He started with setting the context as the Indian Industry was facing an unprecedented challenge of a global pandemic slowing down the economic activities across the county and the world, there was a need to scientifically assess the Impact on each industry. He stressed on the need for an Entrepreneur or the Top Management to conduct the assessment considering the following parameters:

- New needs / Opportunities are getting created because of this situation.
- The "Priorities" of the business have to be recalibrated and reassigned.
- Effective Transition and Success of Work from Home / Delivery models is compelling traditional businesses to explore new models and logistics.
- New Partnership Models and Investment Models are emerging.

Charudatta shared that in order to be able to align / capitalize on the changing reality, companies needs to first assess the impact of the emerging situation on their own business. He proposed the following steps for the assessment:

### Evaluate the Impact of COVID 19 on your company by

- Confirming the scheduled receipt of payments, planned expenses, your bank limits and establish **Cash Flow**
- Categorising the **Inventory** from use / liquidation point of view. Charudatta proposed to liquidate excess inventory to support cash flow requirements.
- Validating the **Sales Forecasts** with clients to plan your production
- Deriving the **Working Capital Requirement**. Charudatta highlighted the need for fairly accurate assessment of the Working Capital for the company to continue operations.
- Ensuring availability of the required material for production by checking your **Supply Chain**
- Optimising **Resources** to meet the expected production demand. Company may explore sharing / renting additional resources to support Working Capital Needs.
- Based on the detailed assessment, the company needs to **Identify Top Challenges**
- Management needs to work with key stakeholders to **Prepare mitigation strategies**
- All the stakeholders need to work together to **Create a Business Continuity Plan covering**
  - Specific Tasks
  - Actions
  - Roles and Responsibilities
  - Resource Requirements
  - Timelines

Charudatta emphasised on the need for the Entrepreneurs to Manage Themselves well by Staying Positive, keeping themselves fit, Meditation and Strengthening bond with Family. He suggested that this opportunity may be utilized to Conduct SWOT Analysis to identify / cover weaknesses, reaching out to more people and Upgrade yourself in terms of Digital Technologies. A possibility of cultivating new habits and developing a Hobby were also discussed.

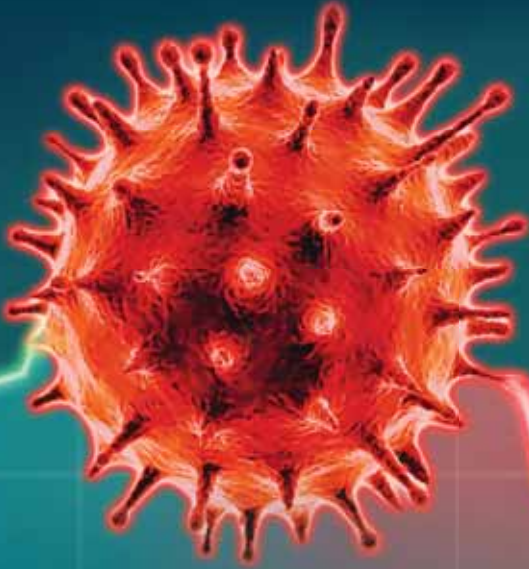



# Mumbai Power Disturbance

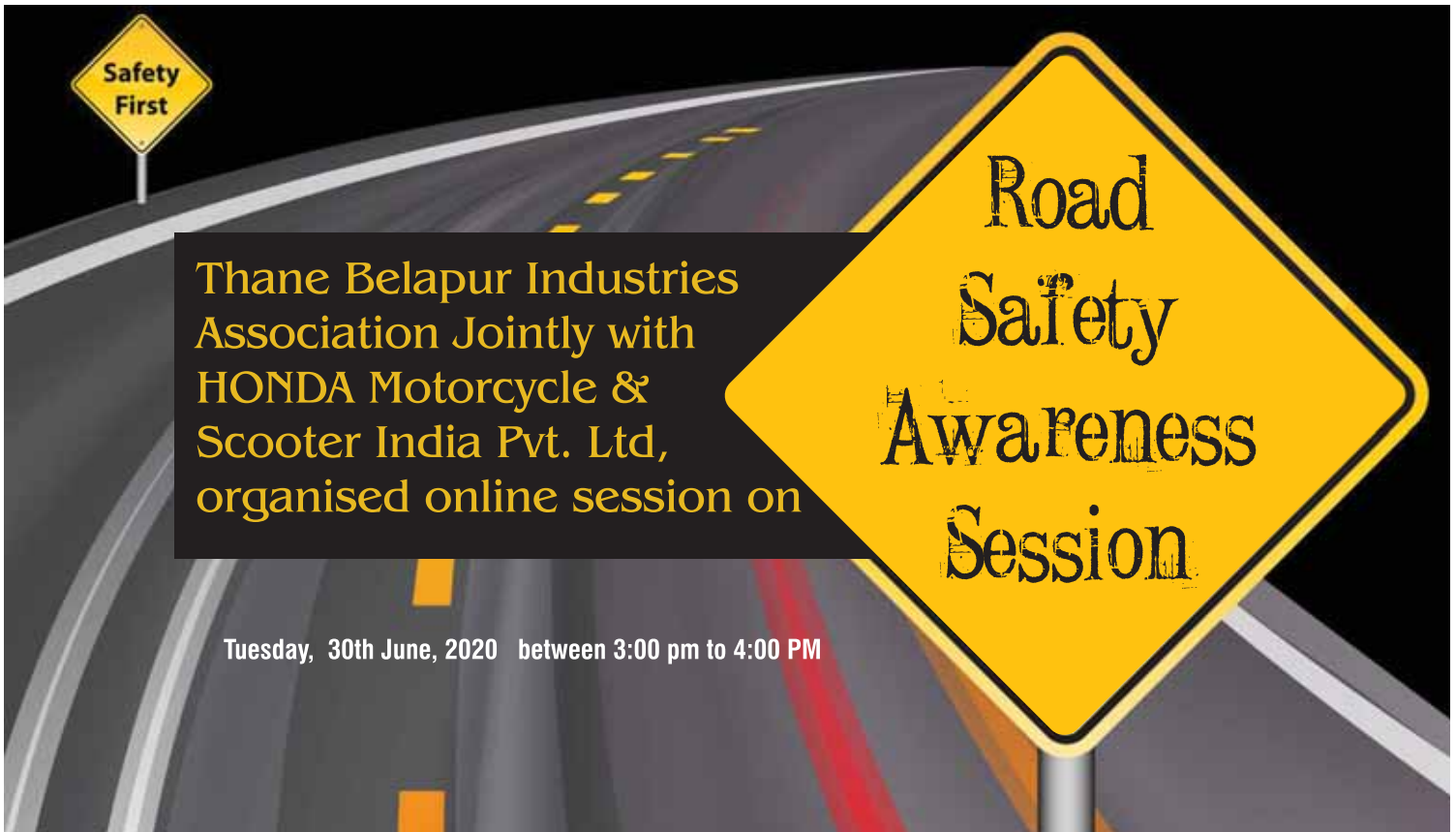
Mumbai has two generators within Mumbai Tata 1100MW and Adani 500 MW { Dahanu Plant dedicated to MUmbai .The total demand is 1600 MW. About 12 years back demand was 1600 MW. Since demand and supply were equal, islanding worked. It meant if there is disturbance outside Mumbai, Mumbai could still get power from inside. Hence, there was no power outage.

This picture today is entirely different. Generally, Mumbai demand reaches 3200 MW whereas on the specific day of the disturbance, it was 2400 MW. So it means 50 % of Mumbai demand was met by bringing power from outside. This power gets in Mumbai via six points: Versova, Borivali, Salsette, Kalia , Kharghar and Trombay. Normally power is carried on 400 KV line from power station. But Mumbai does not have 400 KV station and only has 220 KV. So super urgency was built on the 400 KV station.

On that day, Padhgha Kalwa failed. Due to this, Kharghar was hand tripped i.e. manual intervention took place. Whether this was necessary is being probed. This led to loss of 800 MW to Mumbai and 1800MW to Thane and Navi Mumbai. This overloaded Tata at Chembur and 1100 MW failed. So grossly only 500 MW of Dahanu survived for 40 min. Then 250 MW also tripped. Rest is history.

So, we must have a 400 KV receiving station as well as a robust transmission network as in the future 60 to 70 % demand will be met by bringing power from outside Mumbai. This city has reputation of 120 years of uninterrupted supply. Reputation of city must be upheld.

## NMMC starts hectic antigen testing in MIDC belt

**A team of 200 NMMC workers to test everyone in factories; planning 1,000 antigen tests every day**

The Navi Mumbai Municipal Corporation (NMMC) has launched antigen testing and an intensive RT-PCR testing drive in areas that cover under the Maharashtra Industrial Development Corporation. Beginning this week, all officials, workers and labourers of private factories are being tested on a war footing.

With the state re-opening in its sixth phase, businesses and industries have expressed the need to return to full-time operations. Officials said factory testing is absolutely necessary in this scenario. Two permanent centres have been set up at the Thane-Belapur Industrial office and the local-scale industries office. In addition, over 200 healthcare workers have been deployed in this project and small teams will visit the factories to perform the tests.

Called 'Mission Break the Chain', the drive was launched on Monday by NMMC commissioner Akhilesh Bangia. Since the outbreak of Covid-19, 730 people have succumbed. The nation city has a stock of 36,673, out of which 3,596 are active cases. On Wednesday alone, 416 patients tested positive.

Dr Sachin Nersane, who has been appointed as a special project coordinator, said that the MIDC, Maharashtra Pollution Control Board, the Thane-Belapur Industrial Association and small-scale entrepreneurs' association have agreed to cooperate with the NMMC for this testing drive. "We are planning to do more than 1,000 antigen tests every day. We are running the RT-PCR only on those who show symptoms, even mild," Dr Nersane said.

In the drive on Tuesday, four out of 172 people had tested positive. On Wednesday, the testing was carried out in five places and 1,300 rapid antigen tests were conducted, all of them tested negative. The NMMC collected 128 RT-PCR samples and the reports are expected today.

Navi Mumbai, as per its civic body, has a recovery rate of 98 per cent. Until now, 78,839 RTPCR tests and 1,22,266 antigen tests have been conducted. The NMMC has home-quarantined 34,595 people and 134 patients are currently admitted at its Covid centres.

NMMC officials said they are trying to focus on the 'trace, test and treat' policy to bring the infection rate down. Earlier, the civic body had conducted a similar exercise at the APMC in Vashi. Officials said the industrial belt is vulnerable as it has a chunk of floating population, too.

Simultaneously, the NMMC is also protecting the star's 'My family, my responsibility' mission. This includes door-to-door surveys in co-operative housing societies, NMMC chief Bangia said.

"The NMMC has its own laboratory to conduct 1,000 RTPCR tests per day. We want to assure the citizens that not a single suspected Covid person would be left out."

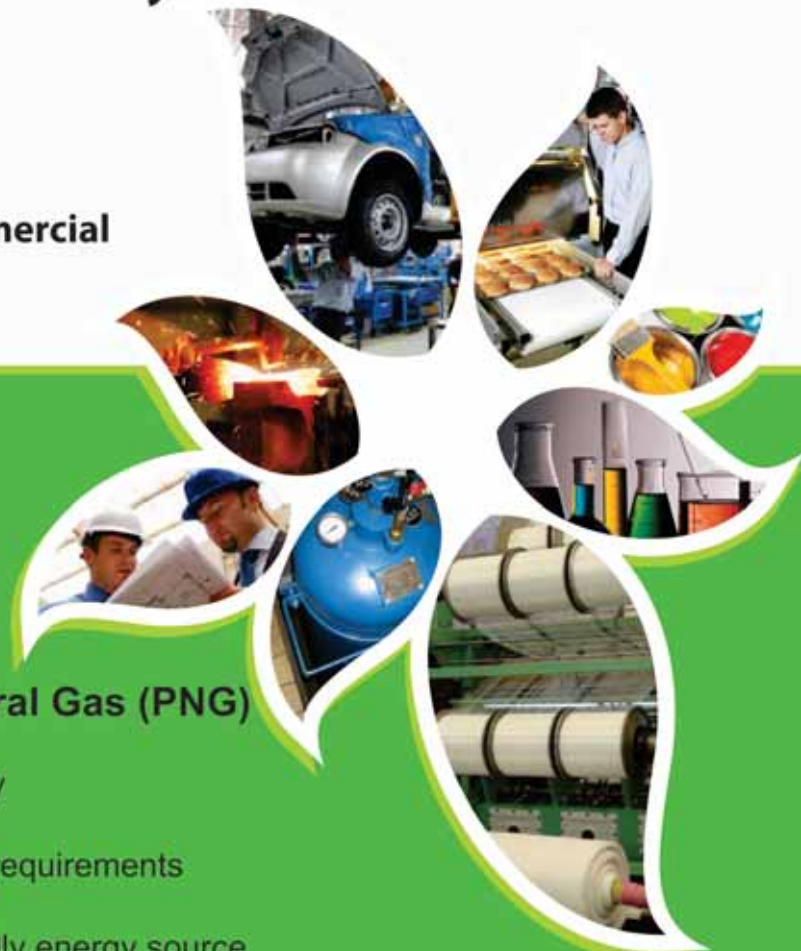






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
