Road Repairs : Near Mukand - by End May. MIDC : 14Kms. Potholes & Repairs. Asphalt by 30th April 2021.
Road Concretization, Turbhe - Uran: 50% Completed , 50% Planned. Drainage shall be completed. Work shall be stopped during Monsoon.

Amrut Jal: Pipe line laying 63 Kms completed. 21kms underway. Mud lifting in progress. Excavation Permission till 25th May 2021. Hard Barricading to be done. Responsibility Contractor and Dept. Ensure No Incidence.
Telecommunication & Pipelines: No Road digging in Monsoon. All work shall be completed by 31st May 2021.
MIDC Raw Material: Lying on the road. Accident Hazard during Monsoon. On Material on the carriage.

MSEDCL: Emergency digging - Inform concerned NMMC Officer in writing. Avoid Inconvenience & Accident.
Repairs to cables, Feeders, DB Maintenance by 31st May. Tree branches trimming. No tree cutting unless it is in dangerous condition.



STP: Open Manholes serious issues.FRP covers floating.

Debris: Responsibility Ex.Engg. not Contractor.

Holding Ponds & Flap Gate: Water logging - preventive measures to be taken. Pumping Stations, Underpass Water Logging- Ensure Backup Pumps. Culverts instead of nallah. Obstruction below Pipelines. Flow and Catchment. SI Group Nallah : Ensure Desilting. No Water Logging in the area.

Water Logging: Chronic Spots to be Identified .High Tide Schedules to be handy. Infrastructure to be ready. Meteorology Dept to be in constant touch. Pumping stations to be set and made ready for next 4 months.

Police(DCP): Pumps to be increased underpass. Ensure no traffic jam. Illegal Slums ,Landslide Spots to be Identified.Avoid Human Accidents.

High Flood: Dam Opening, Establish Communication Channel through Social Media, WhatsApp group.

Potholes on Road: List to be prepared and acted upon. Patni, T Junction, Mukand, Uran. Comprehensive Contract: Penalty, Deterrent steps for sub standard work. Guarantee period : 4 months after completion. Separate Meeting on this issue.

STP: Pumping , Discharge.

Road Related : Reflective Caution Tapes, Zebra crossing, Barricading , Traffic Management. Street Lights in MIDC, NMMC area : In dangerous condition - Top Priority. Maintenance to be ensured.

Potable Water: In Turbhe pipe lines through Gutter. Plan for shifting. Water issues: Proactive steps. Get historic data, serious issue. Turbid Water, No Chlorination. Avoid Water borne disease.

Encroachment: Hawkers, Dangerous Building. During Covid19 Authority was given to JE to take action on Hawkers. Avoid Crowd. Encroachment List to be forwarded by 15th May & Action by 30th May.

Nallah Cleaning: During Swachh Survekshan done. Monsoon Cleaning: Desilting, removing solid waste , providing screens etc.No waste on road in Monsoon, going to drain, bad odour and leachate formation.

Health: Water borne diseases. Brief of Preparedness plan by Ms.Ujwala Oturkar. Malaria: Proactive Survey- Construction, Manufacturing Active case plotting and control measures. Continuous surveillance. Fogging and spraying -Vulnerable areas. Ward Officer to be active.

Garden: Trimming road side trees. Permission for cutting with limited period.

Fire Brigade: Response time to be minimal.

Covid Centres: No Rain water Leakage, Ensure Power supply & No Electrical Short circuit due to rain water. Vaccination shall be continued for the next 3 to 4 Months.



Ward Officer shall be approachable @ any time of the day.

Civil Defence: Protocol of Training, Rescue, Relief in Emergency.

Outstanding of Discom.

MSEDCL,, Tata, Adani and BEST are electricity distribution companies of Maharashtra .They are called Discoms. MSEDCL is largest of nation ,supplying to almost 2.4 crore consumers. It is always on front line for cursing by consumers. Are they the only one responsible ? Annual Revenue Requirements {ARR} is equivalent to turn over the term we use in industry. This is aprx Rs 75,000 cr. And outstanding is Rs 60,000 cr. Think can any one run, any commercial organisation with 80 % its turn over outstanding ? Government funds, hence it is running on its charity.Let us look at four major ones who are responsible for outstanding.

Agriculture. When average cost of power is Rs 7.33 agri consumer pays Rs 1.50. Roughly annual billing is Rs 4800 crores to them. Yet in last seven years maximum collection is Rs 280/320 cr. We have 16 lakhs un metered and 18 lakhs metered agri pumps. Only 10 % of metered pumps readings can be relied upon.But worst is feeders or Transformers supplying to agri pump data is also questionable. So all consumption shown is cooked up figures.So unless correct figures come through , correct old bills give, take tough stand [political support needed] of disconnection ,this mess cant be rectified.

Municipal corporation, Nagar Parishad, Gram panchayat draw power for water pumping and street lights mainly. Aurangabad draws water from Jayakwadi dam 59 Kms away. It is pumped up by 500 meters for gravity feed. Since they have not attended pipe line in has number of holes and year by year pumping HP is going up.Electricity bill of water is roughly Rs 60 lakhs. They collect only 35 lakhs by selling water. Add ,man power, Maintance etc to this. Can this model survive ? So arrears are more than 18 months .Can we disconnect municipality for non payment ? City will have no water. This is repeat performance upto gram panchayats.So unless this model is changed arrears cant be recovered.

Government hospitals, police offices, collectors office , courts, etc just don't pay .Rs 6000 cr is their outstanding. Will police give protection to disconnect their own office. So even chief engineer can only pursue not disconnect. About ten years back Chief ministers Residence at Nagpur *Ramtek*was disconnected by following entire legal process . Result it became national head line for news papers. So outcome ? MD IAS officer transferred within six days. Now which officer will show guts ? Non.

Lastly residential consumers . In Konkan region collection is 99.8 % Take Jalgaon it is around 65/70 %.It means one third population does not pay Assume about 6/7 lakhs population. Can we really disconnect two lakhs consumers for non payment. So unless society makes thinking that there is no free lunch ,it is difficult.

Electricity is a commercial commodity . It is to be purchased may be at even say ,subsidised cost. But it is not birthright. Unless we as society make a change this malice cant be cured.

Highlights of the Meeting

Meeting Details:

A virtual meeting with the Pharmaceutical Industry members of Thane Belapur Industries Association (TBIA) was organised jointly by 2030 WRG, Shawview Consulting and TBIA on January 11, 2021 between 3-4 pm to introduce the concept of responsible Antibiotic Manufacturing platform (RAMP) to reduce AMR in Maharashtra. More than 10 Industry representatives attended the meeting. Specific comments by the participants and the list of attendees are given below.

Specific Comments by the participants

Mr. M. M. Brahme, TBIA:

- Requested for a write up and PPT
- Agreed to convene a meeting with local antibiotic manufacturing companies
- It is important to identify the Antibiotics Manufacturing Units from amongst the TBIA members.
- Supported the idea to approach MIDC, Minister of Industries and other small scale units in the Thane Belapur industrial belt which may not be members of TBIA.
- It is Important to understand the concept of responsible antibiotic manufacturing, the critical parameters, status of current regulations, and to bring more stakeholders to the forum.
- There is a CETP at Thane Belapur Industrial Belt and the industries contribution effluent to this CETP should also be approached to communicate the message of AMR reduction
- The Industries from Taloja Industrial Belt and TBIA should be invited for discussion Mr. Brahme agreed to facilitate a dialogue between RAMP, 2030WRG and the Joint Director, Department of Industries, GoM.
- TBIA would be glad to co-organize / co-host a half day workshop on the topic of reducing AMR through sustainable antibiotic manufacturing. The event could be virtual or hybrid.

Sandoz Ltd.: Interested in getting to know more about the forum, has requested a copy of the presentation.

Glenmark pharma: part of the pharma supply chain, reducing discharge limit would be an important step and he showed interest in getting associated. They have plants in Goa, Ankaleshwar, Dahej and Nashik.

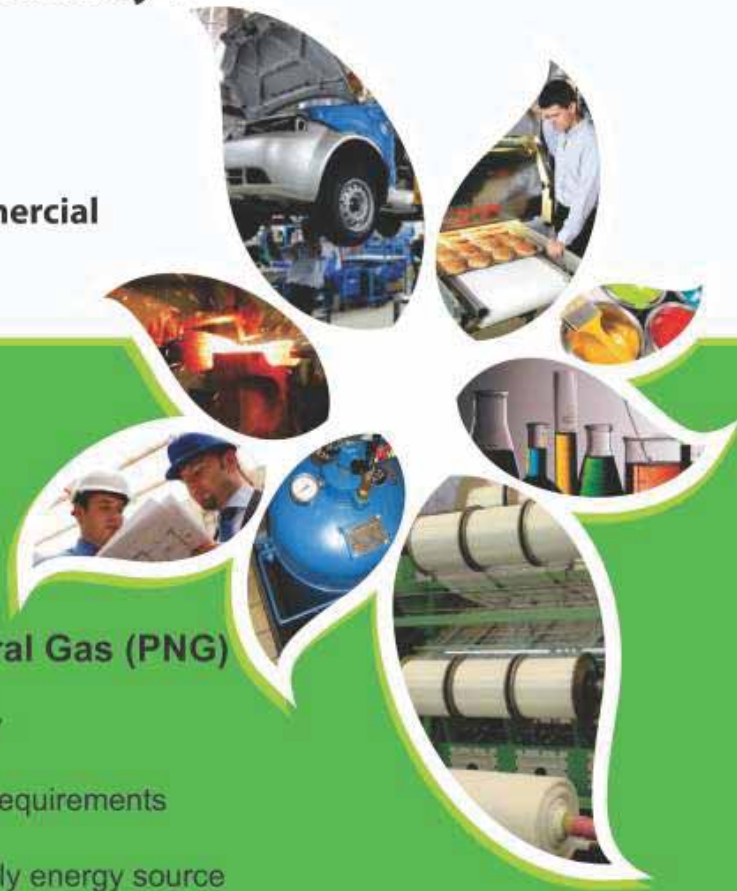
